

(14th Jan. cont.)

Moorie still on sick list.

Taroba, Teoti (son of Temor), wife of Moorie and N.N. all went down in the evening with the curious local malady. Now convinced that this is due to occasionally bad fish from lagoon & the local habit of not cleaning fish properly before eating them. Nobody seriously ill, but a lot of groaning & holding at tummies was apparent. There cannot be anything wrong with the food, unless it be toddy or coconuts, since the people who never get this sickness, as well as myself, eat the same fish and rice and drink the same water.

15th January Wednesday.

Wind North to N.W. Force 3 (nearly four occasionally). Hot and sunny all day. Rainfall - nil.

Magistrate and eight men continue with work on prison. Main woodwork finished & start made at hui te ba walls.

Temor, Reuben, Bawkie continue with latrine work. Latter two plus Const. Telen & prisoner spent p.m. cutting more timber.

Babara, Roccia continue with coconut trees near Manouba. Const. Telen & prisoner (Hulang) engaged a.m. in repairing blinds. Hospital Doctor ill. So A.O. had to turn doctor & tend the sick. Neti has boil on stomach & slight fever. Prescribed regular dosage morphine, also salts for two or three mornings & diminution amount of rice.

Teoti (son of Temor) very ill p.m. Called out Taroba to give him $\frac{1}{12}$ gr. morphine as he was hysterical & getting very weak. With help of this, he managed to get 7 hours sleep & now seems to be on mend. He ate some fish as Taroba but seems to have been more severely affected.
