19th JANUARY SUNDAY.

Wind N.N.W. Force 2/1. Bright and sunny until
about 4:30 p.m. Then overcast & a few spots of
rain.

Just Sunday - mostly spent in working out
practice navigational problems. Colled meeting of
married men after church to discuss matter of
schools. It was agreed that present method of
Wednesday school only was unworkable & children
obtaining no benefit. From to-morrow, therefore, senior
children will have one hours school daily from
5:30 to 6:30 p.m. in two 25 minute classes with
ten minute break in middle - these classes to be
held in A.O.'s house for the present. Wednesday
afternoon school to continue as Kindergarten only.
Certain amount of office work performed in afternoon.
