Your telegram No. 1. Nobody here to whom Gallagher owed money or goods except Native Constable Esela, ex Gallagher's orderly must get £20 from Gallagher's money. This is reason: when Gallagher was alive he already done a will in which appeared Esela must have; and £50 also cooking utensils to his servant Aram. I and Native Wireless Operator Reuben, at present at Suva, signed....?.....will as aforesaid witnesses. Now Esela claims for his share as he has not been received yet.
