With reference to my telegram of the 18th January, I just find that Gallagher owes the Co-operative Store £1:13:11 for tobacco and rice for chickens and dog during the months of June to August, 1941. At that time Gallagher and I left Gardner Island for the Gilbert Islands to collect settlers for the Phoenix Islands, and Native Wireless Operator Reuben looked after the store.

Temou states that he has been made canoe for Gallagher at Funafuti for £7. When canoe was completed Gallagher paid ~~xxx this man~~ him that sum but this man only took £5 and left £2 by Gallagher to keep it. Now Temou wants that money.

I do not know this case. Please ask Aran.
