I have the honour to refer to my telegram No.4 of the 30th January on the subject of the indebtedness of the estate of the late Mr. G.B. Gallagher and to inform you that during a recent visit to Hull Island the manager of the Co-operative Store there informed me that on his last visit to Hull Island Mr. Gallagher purchased 100 sticks of trade tobacco for which he did not pay the store.

2. The price of the tobacco was fourpence per stick so that the estate is indebted to the Hull Island Co-operative store for the sum of £1: 13: 4.
