THURSDAY

5th Nov., 1942.

Labourers continued. Same as yesterday and stopped at 8 a.m. Rest in afternoon.

FRIDAY

6th Nov., 1942.

Labourers continued on their shares and they all done them at about eight a.m. Constable Koela and prisoners painting the roof of store. Iobi, Utia, Bankie Teibi getting fish for ration.
