All men were working on thatch for rethatching Maneaba. Some men went to T. Ndinan to cut some leaves for thatch - the rest in village. They worked in 9 hours (7.0 am - 11.30 am 12.30 pm - 4.0 p.m.)
At 1. pm One American aircraft flying over the island TYPE PB4

TUESDAY

19th January, 1943.

All labourers doing thatch 10 thatch per labourer
No sunshine. Rainy at 4 pm + 6-7 pm.

20th January, 1943.

WEDNESDAY

Labourers continued same as yesterday.
At 7.40 a.m. 3 aircraft flew over us they were appeared ~~from~~ ^{at} E.N.

21st January, 1943.

THURSDAY

Labourers are working on thatch and some of thatch them rethatching Maneaba
At about 7.30 USS aircraft Type PB4 flew over the island

FRIDAY

22th January, 1943.

All labourers ~~are~~ ^{are} cutting timber (Kianawa) in Bush & required from Canton. At about 12 noon 4 aircrafts flew from over Gardner from West. they look like type B24. Another at 1.30 pm the PB4.
As from to day, our food in store is all finish.
