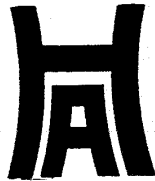

STATEMENT.

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Hazel-Atlas Glass Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of West Virginia, located at Wheeling, Ohio County, West Virginia, and doing business at Wheeling, West Virginia, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the drawing, filed with application for trade-mark Serial No. 191,704, of February 2nd, 1924, for GLASSWARE—NAME-
