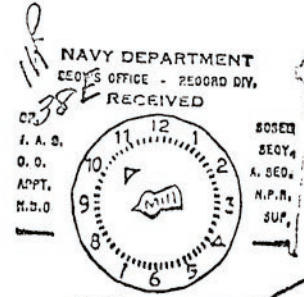

her husband, Mr. Putnam.

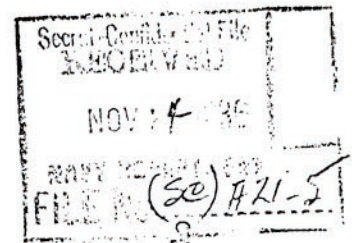
