Dear Sir,

We thank you for your letter of 21st November, 1940, and would advise that our Commercial Operators' Course can be partly studied by correspondence, and this home study portion will cover a period of approximately fifteen (15) months, after which the student would be required to attend the School for a period of three (3) monthsfor the study of practical work associated with the 2nd class Operators' examination.

If a 1st class certificate is required a further three (3) months should be allowed.

The three (3) months mentioned above during which 2nd class practical subjects are studied depends upon the morse standard of the student when he attends the School. If your morse speed is approximately 12 to 15 words per minute three (3) months attendance should be sufficient to enable you to increase your speed to 20 words per minute which is required for the 2nd class examination. If your speed on reaching the School is not as stated above, then it would be necessary for you to attend for a longer period than three (3) months.

The fee for students taking the 2nd class examination is £36/15/-, and this may be paid by instalments of £3/3/- per month. The full Course which includes 1st class subjects may be had for a fee of £52/10/-, the
