at noon - Have afternoon off. C. Ewek + the others same as  
yesterday. At night all people are practise the of their dancing  
<sup>there are</sup> 2 crew classes - the ISLAND labour and Colony staff.

THURSDAY

21<sup>st</sup> May, 1942

Wind East to S/E F 2,3 - Bright sunshine hot. No rain  
Today the magistrate called all the people on their island  
to the maneaba for the trouble was happened last night. The  
trouble is the quarreling between the labourers and Colony p staff  
and <sup>the</sup> N.M wants to get the peace ~~and~~ among them. No work  
all day except except dancing and feast.

FRIDAY

22<sup>nd</sup> May, 1942

Wind East Force 3. Sunny No rain  
Labour continuing on their shares and they all done that  
before noon. Afternoon - off work.
