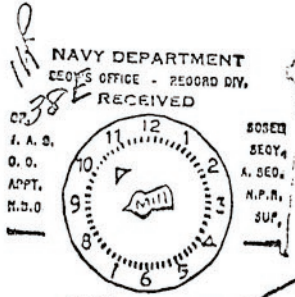

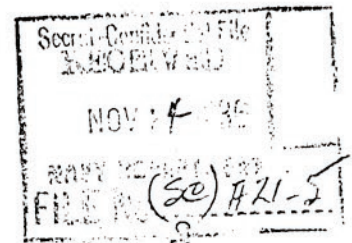
The attached letter was handed me this morning,
