

Dear Miss Earhart:

It has come to the attention of this office that on March 20, 1937, you failed to submit a report of accident, Form 87, to your aircraft, License NR-16020, at Luke Field, Oahu, Territory of Hawaii. As you are no doubt aware, such failure constitutes a violation of Sections 25 (B) and 29 of the Air Commerce Regulations, subject to a civil penalty of \$500, unless mitigated or remitted.

Supervising Inspector Emil Williams of Honolulu, has recommended that no action be taken against you in this instance, but the matter is being made of record.
