Search Map.

Presented here is a digitally restored image of the map used by Fourteenth Naval District Headquarters at Pearl Harbor to track and manage the Earhart search. Note that the map only extended as far south as 2° 30' South Latitude. Latitude and longitude lines were added by hand to enable McKean and Gardner Islands to be plotted. The lines that cross near Gardner Island represent Pan American direction finder bearings from Wake and Mokapu, the Coast Guard direction finder bearing from Howland Island, and the 157-337 line of position described in the last in-flight transmission heard by *Itasca*. The notes in the lower right corner are unrestored and illustrate the poor condition of the original image.
