

# Noonan's South Atlantic Chart.

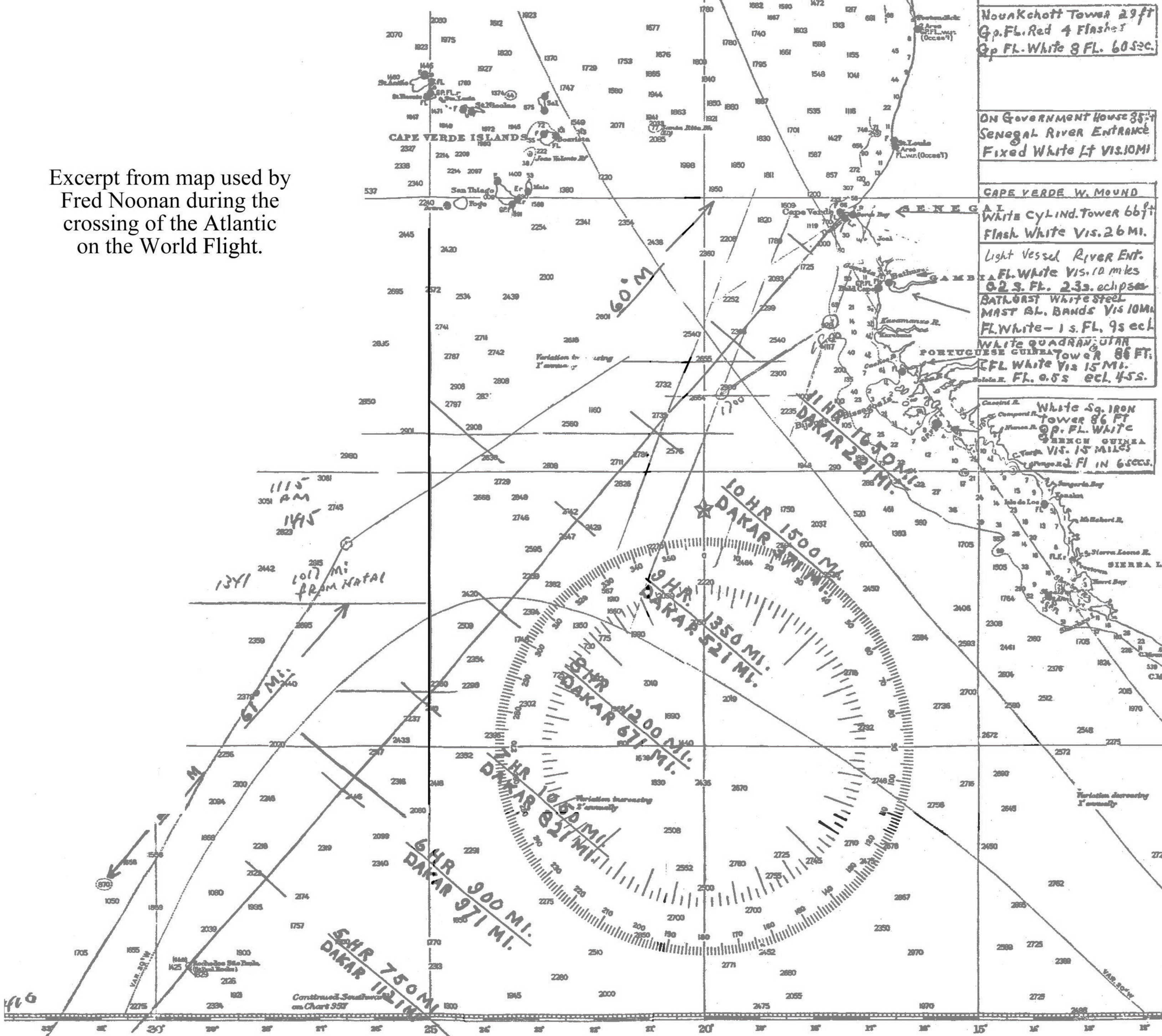
